

2024 CDM+ COG Electronic Voting

Suran Systems, Inc is excited to offer an electronic interface to the voting program in the CDM+ COG state office program.

Using the Apple iPod touch devices we are able to display a list of possible candidates for each ballot. Before casting the vote the minister would have to enter in their Ministerial number and the system would only allow one ballot per voting session. A minister would then scroll through an alphabetical list of those eligible to be voted on and select their choice. After the pre-determined number of candidates is selected the minister would review their choices and then cast their vote. These devices would be connected wirelessly to a private secured server (provided by Suran Systems, Inc.). Results of the voting would be immediately available to the Teller Committee.

Key features

- Easy to use interface with no numbers to enter in to cast a vote
- · Review list of candidates voted on before casting vote
- Only those eligible to be voted on will be presented in the list
- Devices can be easily shared to help minimize the cost of providing electronic voting
- Setup of voting sessions is validated against your current CDM+ ministerial database
- Initial voting sessions can be setup before the voting event to facilitate quick and accurate voting
- Last minute changes to those eligible to be voted on can be made on-site
- Results can be viewed through a web-based link (this assumes the presentation computer is connected to the internet or can be networked to our local server).

*Cost includes devices, two days on-site and travel to the voting site. Costs of hotel or hotel like accommodations near the voting location will be the responsibility of the state office. We would need at least one designated person provided by the office to assist Suran Systems Inc. personnel in the setting up, passing out and receiving of equipment. We would come in the day before the event to make sure everything is setup and ready to go. If the voting will require us to be on-site for more than one day (not including the setup day) then an additional \$500 plus travel will be charged. Any devices not returned or damaged due to mis-handling will be expensed to the state office at \$250 per device.

A non-refundable deposit of \$500 is required to schedule electronic voting from Suran Systems Inc. Half of remaining amount owed will be due and payable 60 days prior to the event and the balance would be invoiced and payable within 30 days after the event. Only checks or ACH withdraw is acceptable payment for the electronic voting fees.
